If you would like to be added to our list for a puppy, or a specific upcoming litter, please enclose a \$500.00 deposit in the form of a personal check written to "Scott Lamky", or prepayment along with this completed questionnaire (mailing address is at header of first page). Note that payment is non-refundable, should you change your mind, but is refundable if we do not have a puppy for you or you can choose to roll it over to the next litter. Shipping fees are \$350, plus actual cost of airfare (covers airline approved shipping crate, ISO compliant microchip, first round of vaccinations, dewormings, Veterinary Health Certificate, and transportation to airport). Puppy pick-up fees are \$150-\$200 (covers ISO compliant microchipping, first round of vaccinations and deworming before your puppy comes home to you). Most Shiloh Breeders recommend pet insurance. We use Pets Best Pet Insurance here at Stunning. You will be given the date of the Litter Evaluation one month after pups are whelped.

How it works: Once your deposit is received by Stunning Shilohs, you will receive email updates (done via bcc for privacy) on all the breeding activities that take place. You will find out as soon as the dam goes into heat, when they are bred, when they whelp and you will get photo and/or video updates approximately three days after being born and approximately every 2 weeks. The litter will be evaluated between 7.5 and 8.5 weeks of age and puppies will be matched with the families immediately following the litter evaluation. It is important for you to be very clear on what you are looking for and where you can be flexible. Please note that contracts and agreements must be read, filled out and signed by buyer and complete payment received by Stunning Shilohs two weeks prior to the litter evaluation. Failure to do so may impact your getting a puppy from your chosen litter and you may have to wait for the next available litter. Puppies are ready to go to their new homes typically the day of or following the litter evaluation. Please make sure that you provide a phone number to us for the puppy placement phone call.
